PORTS OF CALL



MANDRAKI OLD PORT

The gateway to the Old City of Rhodes. The statues of the two deer stand where once stood Colossus of Rhodes. Opposite, by the city walls there is the castle of St. Nickolas, now a lighthouse, and the beautiful Old Windmills



AGANDOU BEACH

This is one of the best beaches of the island. A stretch of six kilometers of turquoise, crystal clear waters.

At its one end there are the caves of Traganou.



KALITHEA SPRINGS BAY

The springs with the healing properties protected by the ancient Greek God Poseidon. A point of interest combining natural beauty, history and architecture and a perfect spot for swimming



ANTHONY QUINN BAY

This magnificent miniature bay features imposing rock formations and is named after the famous actor. Its clrear deep waters are ideal for diving and snorkeling
